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Regardless of Race, Color, or Creed...

1. An education that offers me opportunity for inquiry and development to any fullest potential.
2. An educational climate where the well being of all students is of primary concern.
3. An educational staff that exhibits a positive role model for his/her development.
4. The guidance of understanding teachers, administrators and school district staff.
5. Constructive discipline for the development of good character, conduct, and habits.
6. Security in the school community against influences detrimental to proper development.
7. The opportunity to develop and express his/her opinions, beliefs, and values with dignity.
8. Have the rules of the school in writing.
9. Consideration as an individual in the educational environment.
10. Health with psychological services to permit his/her physical, mental, and social development.
11. Guidance in choosing appropriate courses of study.
12. An appropriate education and/or remediation to serve special needs.
13. The selection of wholesome extra-curricular activities.
14. The opportunity to approach teachers and administrators with reasonable requests and questions concerning my education.
