

**Policy**

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NAMING BUILDINGS AND PROGRAMS

The Alloway Township Board of Education shall have the responsibility of naming facilities. Facilities which may be named include, but are not limited to, auxiliary buildings, gymnasiums, auditoriums, libraries, athletic fields and playgrounds.

School facilities, both on school grounds and within school buildings, shall be named only by formal action of the board. In naming school facilities, the board shall strive to honor the history, traditions and vision of the school district and the community it serves. While certain facilities may be named after individuals or institutions whose service to, or support of the district and to the community have been significant, school buildings themselves, subsequent to the date of this policy, shall not be named after individual persons.

The board welcomes recommendations from members of the community in the naming of school facilities. All requests must be submitted in writing to the board. The board will consider all names submitted. While community input is encouraged, the final decision shall be made by the board.
