Dear Alloway Township School Families:

NJSLA or New Jersey Student Learning Assessments for Spring 2024 will be held starting on Monday, May 13, 2024, for Grades 3-8. These computer-based assessments measure our students' progress in meeting the state learning standards for their grade level in ELA, Math, and Science in Gr. 5 and 8. The data that we receive, in addition to our local assessments, helps to provide a more complete picture of what our students know and can do. The results also provide valuable information about our curriculum and instruction practices and help us identify any changes we may need to make. In the late summer or fall, individual score reports will be sent home to the parents and guardians.
