What is Title 1?

- Largest federal elementary and secondary education program
- Allocation based on poverty data
- Provides supplemental funds in schools with concentrations of low-income students to have an equal opportunity to achieve levels of proficiency
- Provides ALL children significant opportunity to fair, equitable and high quality education

Title I School Wide Model

- Our school does not meet the 40% poverty rate, but our grant waiver was accepted.
- Provides additional services that increase the amount and quality of instructional time
- Upgrade the educational program of the school
- ALL students, staff, and families eligible for Title I funded services.

Title 1 Schoolwide Model

- Three Core Elements
 - Needs Assessment
 - Annual School Plan
 - Annual Evaluation
- Benefits
 - Use of funds to upgrade the entire school
 - All students, teachers, and parents contribute to the goals
