# Programs



## Pre - K

- **No tuition and no charge for busing**
- **Not eligible for state funding**
- **Required for 3-year-olds and 4-year-olds who are classified Special Education**
- **2 sessions: AM and PM**

# Programs



## Special Education

- **Elementary: in-class support (ICS) or in-class resource (ICR)**
- **Middle: ICS, ICR, resource, and self-contained**
- **Various out of district placements**
- **Funded through IDEA grant**
- **Share services of our Child Study Team (CST) with Upper Pittsgrove**

# Programs



## Supportive Opportunities for Academic Resources (SOAR)

- **Funded through Title 1**
- **Elementary Math: small group sessions during Tiger Time**
- **Elementary LAL: small group sessions during Tiger Time**
- **Middle Math & LAL: instructional aide for support**
- **Formerly called BSI**

# Programs



## Other:

- **School Age Child Care (SACC): before and after school care**
- **Middle: Semester Visual/Performing Arts courses**
- **Elementary & Middle: New digital literacy courses**
- **12 after school clubs**

# Finances



- **Budget is 7.7 million**
- **State aid is projected to decrease by \$700,000. over next 6 years**
- **Tax levy can increase annually by a maximum of 2%**
- **New for 2019-20: charter school tuition projected to be ~\$83,000.**





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
