7. Resolution to approve Reduction in State Aid

School Districts were notified on July 14, 2017 of <u>revised state aid revenue</u> due to revisions made on July 4, 2017 to the <u>State's budget</u>. The Alloway Board of Education lost \$29,304 in State Adjustment Aid for its 2017-18 budget. The Board has 3 options for adjusting its budget, which are as follows:

- 1. Use surplus to maintain budgeted appropriations, or
- 2. Reduce appropriations for 2017-18; or
- 3. A combination of 1 and 2 above.

It is the recommendation of the Administration to maintain budgeted appropriations for 2017-18, as approved at our public hearing on April 25, 2017, as Alloway has a tight budget for 2017-18. The rationale for using excess surplus is that also on July 14, 2017, the Alloway School district was notified of its 2016-17 Extraordinary Aid allocation, which was \$27,024 more than anticipated at budget time (\$105,122 actual vs \$78,098 budgeted).

The Board approve by resolution the use of surplus in the amount of \$29,304 due to the elimination of Adjustment Aid following the notification of revised state aid received on July 14, 2017.

9. Tuition Contract-Egg Harbor Twp School

The Board approve entering into a tuition contract with Egg Harbor Township School District for a 7th grade student (TB) residing at Ranch Hope and attending 7th grade at Alloway School. Total tuition for this student will be \$10,900. The tuition contract represents revenue to Alloway School district.

10. Transportation Jointure-Egg Harbor Twp School

The Board approve the Joint Transportation Agreement between the Alloway Board of Education and the Egg Harbor Township Board of Education, effective September 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018. This Agreement is for the transportation of 1 student (TB), currently residing at Ranch Hope to Alloway School, in the amount of \$1,080 (\$6.00 per day). This jointure represents revenue to the Alloway School District.

11. <u>Tuition Contract-Atlantic City</u>

The Board approve entering into a tuition contract with Atlantic City School District for an 8th grade student (JT) residing at Ranch Hope and attending 8th grade at Alloway School. Total tuition for this student will be \$10,900. The tuition contract represents revenue to Alloway School district.

12. <u>Transportation Affiliation Agreement-Atlantic City</u>

The Board approve the Transportation Affiliation Agreement between the Alloway Board of Education and the Atlantic City Board of Education, effective September 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018. This Agreement is for the transportation of 1 student (JT),

currently residing at Ranch Hope to Alloway School, in the amount of \$1,080 (\$6.00 per day). This jointure represents revenue to the Alloway School District.

Transportation Affiliation Agreements-Middle Township and Trenton
The Board approve the Transportation Affiliation Agreement between the Alloway Board of Education and the Middle Township Board of Education, effective September 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018. This Agreement is for the transportation of 1 student (BW), currently residing at Ranch Hope to Woodstown High School, in the amount of \$3600 (\$20.00 per day). This jointure represents revenue to the Alloway School District. Further, the Board approve the Transportation Affiliation Agreement between the Alloway Board of Education and the Trenton Board of Education, effective September 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018. This Agreement is for the transportation of 1 student (DD), currently residing at Ranch Hope to Woodstown High School, in the amount of \$3600

14. <u>Tuition Contract-Bridgeton</u>

The Board approve a tuition contract with Bridgeton Public Schools for a 1st grade student (JT) who is currently enrolled as a homeless student in the Alloway School district. Tuition for this student will be \$10,900 for the 2017-18 school year.
