2024-2025 Budget Development

October: Board of Education approved Budget Development Schedule (tentative)

December - March: Meetings held with CSA, Facility Manager, Technology Support Personnel, Child Study Team members, etc. to determine staffing needs, student placement recommendations/enrollment projections, facility/maintenance priorities, technology needs (student/staff level); Fixed costs (employee benefits, district insurances, transportation, utilities, leases, etc.) incorporated into projected budget

February: Governor Murphy's Budget Message State Aid figures released

Decrease in aide (\$736,784.00)

March: Finance Committee met to review aspects of budget

Revenue (state aid, excess surplus, local tax levy); Appropriations (major categories)

Board of Education approved the preliminary budget for submission to the County Office of Education (Budget submitted by March 20 deadline)

County of Education approval after reviewed by Executive County Business Office.

Public Hearing and final adoption of budget by Board of Education.

- Special Subjects
