ADMINISTRATIVE LEEWAY IN ABSENCE OF BOARD POLICY

In cases where immediate action must be taken within the Alloway Township School District school system when the board has provided no guidelines for administrative action, the chief school administrator shall have the power to act, but the chief school administrator's decisions shall be subject to review by the board at its next regular meeting.

It shall be the duty of the chief school administrator to inform the board promptly of such action and of the need for policy.
