## ASSIGNMENT; TRANSFER

The chief school administrator shall make certified staff assignments in the manner best calculated, in their judgment, to enhance the educational program.

Teaching, supervisory, administrative and support personnel are subject to assignment and transfer after recommendation of the chief school administrator and approval by the board. Procedures for such transfers shall comply with provisions of current negotiated agreements and state and federal law.

Disciplinary transfers are prohibited. Particular attention shall be paid to ensuring, to the extent possible, that there shall be equivalence of teachers and administrative staff within the school. Discrimination in assignment, transfer and promotion shall not be tolerated (see 2224, 4111 and 4111.1).

The chief school administrator or designee shall monitor district promotion, assignment and transfer practices to ensure nondiscrimination.
