- 1. An education that offers me opportunity for inquiry and development to any fullest potential.
- 2. An educational climate where the well being of all students is of primary concern.
- 3. An educational staff that exhibits a positive role model for his/her development.
- 4. The guidance of understanding teachers, administrators and school district staff.
- 5. Constructive discipline for the development of good character, conduct, and habits.
- 6. Security in the school community against influences detrimental to proper development.
- 7. The opportunity to develop and express his/her opinions, beliefs, and values with dignity.
- 8. Have the rules of the school in writing.
- 9. Consideration as an individual in the educational environment.
- 10. Health with psychological services to permit his/her physical, mental, and social development.
- 11. Guidance in choosing appropriate courses of study.
- 12. An appropriate education and/or remediation to serve special needs.
- 13. The selection of wholesome extra-curricular activities.
- 14. The opportunity to approach teachers and administrators with reasonable requests and questions concerning my education.
