The purpose of the Honor Roll is to recognize worthy students in all established curriculum areas approved by the Alloway Township Board of Education. The Board feels it is important to acknowledge as many students as possible and thus has established the following criteria. There shall be 2 honor rolls for grades 5 - 8.

1. First Honors – for outstanding performance. To qualify for First Honors, a student shall earn the following:

Advanced courses A's Regular courses A's Special courses O's or S's

2. Second Honors – for excellent performance. To qualify for Second Honors, a student shall earn the following:

Advanced courses A's or B's Regular courses A's or B's Special courses O's or S's

- 3. An "N" or "U" in any subject, regardless of grades attained in other subjects, will result in no honor roll status.
- 4. A list of First Honors and Second Honors recipients will be completed and reported at the end of each marking period to the office.
- 5. Congratulatory certificates will be sent to all recipients of First and Second Honors. A list of Honor Roll recipients will also be sent to the local newspaper.
