### Band/Choir Responsibilities

#### **Our Goal**

Thank you for choosing to join a music ensemble. Music has become a very important part of what is offered to students here at The Alloway Township School District. It is important to understand that by choosing to study music, the student is taking on some **added responsibilities**. The goal for our program is to create students who take on these responsibilities and work together with themselves and faculty to become better musicians and overall students.

#### **Instruments**

Students that choose to sign up for band will need to have an instrument to participate. Information can be provided if you would like to rent an instrument through an outside source. It is the responsibility of the student to maintain proper care of all instruments. We urge the students and their families to see that the instruments are treated with respect.

#### **Attendance**

It is crucial to have everyone's attendance all the time to truly be successful in lessons and group rehearsals. However, in the cases where students cannot attend a scheduled rehearsal, lesson, or other function, 1 unexcused absence will be granted. Any more than that and the student may be eliminated from the program. All choir and band rehearsals will be held before school starting at 7am. In-school lesson times will be posted on monthly calendars.

#### **Behavior**

The band and choir, just like any family, requires respect from all of its members to function. This includes students and staff. Having respect for one another includes behaviors like complimenting, supporting, and helping each other. It does NOT include behaviors like belittling, bullying, putting down, or invading personal space in any way. Problems will be handled swiftly and fairly and any student who continuously fails to show the proper behaviors will be dismissed from the program and the band or choir family.

#### **Concerts**

Being a part of a music ensemble has the benefit of performing in multiple concerts during the school year. These are an opportunity for students to share with the community all of their hard work. For the performances to be a success they require full attendance from every band member. Students who fail to attend a concert may be removed from the program.
